

Columbiana County Fish & Game Association Indoor Range Rules

(The CCFAGA reserves the right to refuse entrance and/or use of the range to any person, for any reason.)
Range Officers have complete authority. Disputes to be brought before Club Officers at monthly meetings.

Individuals must read range rules and sign in prior to shooting.

- Anyone handling a firearm in an unsafe manner will be asked to leave.
 - NO drug and/or alcohol use is permitted. Violators will be asked to leave.
- 1) Only the range officer may open and close door entrance to range.
 - a) No entrance or exit permitted during live fire.
 - 2) Range commands must be followed at all times.
 - 3) Everyone must wear ear and eye protection while on range during live fire.
 - 4) No loaded weapons behind the **RED** line or outside of range.
 - 5) Shooters must remain in front of **YELLOW** line during live fire.
 - 6) Concealed Carry firearms must remain on person and concealed.
 - 7) Action on firearms must be locked open while handling, inspecting or making adjustments.
 - 8) No more than one shooter allowed on a lane without range officer approval.
 - 9) Firearms are to be pointed toward backstop/downrange at all times.
 - 10) Shooting across lanes prohibited.
 - 11) Dry firing is permitted on firing line only. Dry firing behind **RED** line or off range prohibited.
 - 12) Exchange of firearms between lanes prohibited. (Switch shooters not firearms.)
 - 13) Any and all malfunctions, accidental discharges and/or damages must be reported to range officer immediately.
 - 14) Adults must accompany all persons under the age of 18 at all times while on range.
 - 15) All firearms and ammunition are subject to inspection and approval by range officers.
 - 16) All ammunition must be lead or copper washed. (rainier type bullets)
 - 17) No full metal jacket, steel jacket, steel core or semi-jacketed ammunition.
 - 18) No rifle caliber ammunition, black powder or magnum loads on range.
 - 19) Firearms deemed unsafe by range officers will not be permitted.
